## Step 1

Educators gain **instant access to interactive** summary and detailed **reports**.

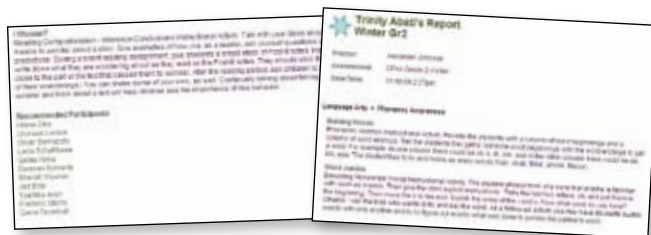
